

Thank you for your request for information dated 3rd October 2012 and received on 3rd October 2012 concerning Northbrook College.

This request is being handled under the Freedom of Information Act 2000.

In regards to question one of your Freedom of Information request, I can confirm that the overall budget for academic year 2010-11 was 25.4 Million.

In regards to question two of your Freedom of Information request, I can confirm that that Northbrook College holds some of the information requested. However we are withholding that information since we consider that the exemption Section 21 applies (Information Reasonably Accessible by Other Means), as the information asked for is detailed within our company accounts which the College has supplied.

In regards to question three of your Freedom of Information request, I can confirm that that Northbrook College holds some of the information requested. However we are withholding that information since we consider that the exemption Section 21 applies (Information Reasonably Accessible by Other Means), as the information asked for is detailed within our annual report which the College has supplied.

In regards to question four of your Freedom of Information Request, the College can confirm that it does not currently use EIS or SENESS.

In regards to question five of your Freedom of Information Request, I can neither confirm nor deny that Northbrook College holds some of the information you requested. However we are withholding that information since we consider that the exemptions Section 43 - sub section (2) and Section 41 apply. In all the circumstances of the case, the public interest in maintaining the exemption outweighs the public interest in disclosing the information.


