Mobile Communications

1. The name of the company who provides mobile communications to Northbrook College is O2 Cellular Solutions.
2. The total number of mobile handsets in use by Northbrook College for staff use is between 150 and 175 handsets.
3. I am writing to inform you that we have searched our records and the information you requested is not held by Northbrook College.
4. A) The annual costs for mobile communications are: 09-10 £24,047.31, 10-11 £21,760.88 and 11-12 £22,405.65.
B) There are costs attributed to mobile handsets purchased. I am writing to inform you that we have searched our records and the information you requested regarding these costs are not held by Northbrook College.

4. The values of these contracts are: £0 and £3,000 one-off installation with £3,235 per month rental.


