Thank you for your request for information dated 25th January 2013 and received on 28th January 2013 concerning Northbrook College.

This request is being handled under the Freedom of Information Act 2000.

However we are withholding that information since we consider that the exemption Section 21 applies (Information Reasonably Accessible by Other Means), as the information asked for is detailed within our company accounts which the College has supplied with this response.

Regarding question one of your Freedom of Information request concerning total funding amounts for 2012-13, I am writing to inform you that we have searched our records and the information you requested is not held by Northbrook College.


